- To employ the professional staff of the Association
- To manage the operational honorary staff of the Association
- To promote and market the image of the Association
- To act as an ambassador /representative for the Association

Strategic Planning

- To plan the future development of Volleyball in England
- To direct the implementation of strategic development plans
- To monitor strategic development plans
- To provide example, direction and monitoring of equity principles within the Association

Volleyball

- To promote and develop Volleyball in England
- To represent the EVA with international bodies e.g. FIVB, CEV
- To represent the EVA with outside agencies e.g. CCPR, Sport England, UK Sport, National and Local Government
- To represent the EVA on the BVF

Management

- To chair the Executive Board and General Meetings, missing no more than three consecutive meetings, and to provide leadership to the Board and the EVA.
- To discuss with Board members long term strategy in respect to Executive Planning and direction.

- To assist Board members with annual target setting and budget making, and to receive annual budget statements
- To receive work programmes and plans from Board members
- To monitor Board performance, against business programme and budget targets, on a cyclical two monthly basis
- To attend Management Committee, Commission and other meetings as appropriate
- To report to the Annual General Meeting by means of a written report within the Annual Report
- To act as a signatory for the Association
